1. CANCELLATION OF THE MOL PROGRAM IN NO WAY ALTERS THE SECURITY
POLICY WITH RESPECT TO CONTRACTOR SOLICITATION OF NEW BUSINESS. THE
SPECIFIC GUIDELINES SPELLED OUT IN THE LETTER ENTITLED "MOL SECURITY
POLICY ON MOL CONTRACTOR'S SOLICITATION OF NEW BUSINESS" (OCT 68)
REMAIN TOTALLY IN FORCE AND SHOULD BE INCLUDED IN YOUR COMPANY'S
FUTURE PLANNING. SPECIFIC ATTENTION IS DIRECTED TO PARAGRAPH III:
". . . . MOL CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS MUST OBTAIN THE APPROVAL
OF THE MOL SYSTEMS OFFICE PRIOR TO (1) USING MOL TECHNICAL DATA IN
RESPONDING TO ANY REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR THE US GOVERNMENT, ANY
OTHER GOVERNMENT, OR ANY COMMERCIAL OR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION;
(2) ENGAGING IN ANY "SELLING" ACTIVITY, OR SENDING UNSOLICITED
PROPOSALS USING ANY REFERENCES TO, OR DATA FROM, THE MOL PROGRAM
TO ANY POTENTIAL CUSTOMER."
