MEMORANDUM FOR MR. BARFIELD, ODDR&E

SUBJECT: Technology Meeting Minutes

We have reviewed the draft of the meeting summary of the Technology Committee Meeting held 9 December 1976. The minutes accurately reflect the events of the meeting; we do, however, have two modifying comments.

In paragraph 1. a. of the Action and Decision Summary, we wish to point out that the technology revelation issue is separate from the data dissemination issue. This latter item still needs to be resolved as a separate topic.

In the penultimate chart attached to the minutes, we call attention to the anticipated 11 meter ground resolution for the Metritek camera using type 3414 film. While we have anticipated approval of a new policy permitting 10 meter resolution in the civil community, the standing guideline is presently 20 meters. Therefore, NASA should obtain approval from the Special Coordinating Committee prior to making firm plans to fly a camera with better than 20 meter ground resolution capability.
