


MEMORANDUM FOR MR. PLUMMER

SUBJECT: Fubini Panel

Dr. Perry, Chairman of the DIA Scientific Advisory Committee, called me regarding the meeting of the Fubini Panel held on the West Coast. He informed me that based on verbal inputs from you, Carl Duckett, General Tighe and General Graham, that they had reworked the Terms of Reference for the Panel. He indicated that the Terms of Reference had been toned down and now he felt they were consistent with the desires of all concerned. He further indicated that Major Frank Cardile was the Executive Secretary and could provide us with the minutes which would contain the revised Terms of Reference. I have requested a copy of the minutes, when available, from Major Cardile.

Dr. Perry indicated that in spite of Mr. Duckett's concern about Fubini heading the Panel that there would be no attempt to change the Chairman of the Panel. Also, that the next meeting of the Panel would be in Washington on March 6th or 7th.
