In regard to the current Cuban reconneiscance overations. and to clarify questions raised by the referenced meno, the Joint Chiefs of Staff are responsible for the operational planning to cover specified reconnelssance objectives, and for all aspects of actual reconnectionate operations in accordance with approved plane. The Joint Chiefs of Steff are delegating to appropriate illusery comunions subordinate responsibilities for the planning and amountion of these operations.

. The JCS focal point for these operations is the Joint Reconneissance Conter. Eines agreement has been reached with the Joint Chiefs of Staff concerning the placing of a CIA Licison officer within the Juint Recommissance Center, I assume this officer is herping the Tophty Director (Research) appropriately advised of these reconnectance operations.

The Defense Intelligence Agency is responsible for recommonding recommaissance objectives on the basis of MPIC carlysis of previous mission results, CARR recommendations for additional target coverage, and tactical military requirements. Specific recommendations of the Deputy Director (Research) are incorporated in the development of the total objectives. Specific approvals . on an individual aircraft and moute basis, as you know, are given by the Executive Committee of the National Security Council.

The Director, NEO Staff, is responsible for advising the Director, Program "B" of all matters affecting CIA participation in the NEP.

In regard to the suggestion in the referenced memo concorning the establishment of CIA lisison with the MRO staff, I believe that the assignment of an individual solely for a lisison function is incompatible with the condept underlying the MRO. The MRO staff presently has Agency personnel assigned on a full-time basis. I feel that any additional staff membership also must be on the basis of full-time participation as an actual member of the MRO staff, assigned specific staff duties. The introduction of a lisison person into such a jointly memod staff would unquestionably be divisive, accentuate organizational differences, and impade the realization of an effective, cohesive, single MRO staff.
