SUBJECT: Executive Order 11905--Restrictions on
Electronic Surveillance

Reference the attached memorandum from General Kulpa, the Staff has been in the process of formulating a package for you to forward to the OSD General Counsel, who has been designated as the DOD implementing authority for the Executive Order. I have advised General Kulpa that you share his views. In accordance with your direction to address both signals and photo intelligence restrictions in working the Executive Order, the package will:

- a. Define our domestic signals and photo requirements vis-a-vis the Executive Order;
- b. Request that authority be delegated to conduct essential domestic NRP activities on the basis of the unique nature of our requirements;
- c. Outline and request approval of the NRP procedures, as required by the Executive Order, for conducting and managing domestic surveillance requirements.

In preparing this package, the Staff will be working closely with personnel from each Program Office, the Air Force General Counsel through Major [redacted] and with the IC Staff. In addition to the package for you to forward to Mr. Wiley, the OSD General Counsel, we will have available a specific breakout of each of our recurring photo and SIGINT domestic requirements. We anticipate having the package within the next two weeks.
