1. The reference TWX reported the planned travel of the Resident Office Staff for the period 10-21 April 1967. This memorandum will focus attention on the activity of the staff during the period 3 thru 7 April 1967.

Back-up commanding system is being used. This "method" of commanding is very slow causing some loss of take due to short command time available. Light spots in commanding have been worked around by careful planning with the SOC.
