MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: NRP Support R&D Program

Mr. Plummer made several comments of note during the review of the NRP Support R&D Program Review. He asked if Maj General Bradburn, Les Dirks, Rear Adm Geiger and Colonel Wheeler all agreed to the breakout. It was explained by Colonel Rosenberg that none of those individuals had attended the R&D review on the West Coast but had sent representatives. It was further indicated that all of the individuals would probably not agree with the breakout and, in fact, it might well not be possible to get them to agree. Mr. Plummer reluctantly seemed to agree and I pointed out that I felt in the final analysis that he, Mr. Plummer, should be the one who approved the budget the way he saw it. Mr. Plummer indicated to me after the meeting that he and I in particular and everyone in general should, by asking questions and making comments, attempt to spur the Program Office Directors to become more familiar with the R&D Program including the activities in the other program offices.
