SUBJECT: Functional Review of Indications and Warning Resources

In your memorandum of March 28, 1974, you requested NRO participation in a review of intelligence resources to support the crisis management function. The NRO will be happy to contribute to this review and I have directed my Staff to provide full support in this endeavor.

As you know, the NRO role is principally one of acquisition and operation of intelligence collection resources, rather than exploitation and dissemination of the product. However, I believe the planned review should give the NRO more visibility into interfacing areas and assist in our planning for future NRO system configurations.

My Staff has already contacted [REDACTED] on preparations for the NRO briefing and will continue to work closely with him in structuring the presentation.

I and/or General Kulpa plan to attend as many of the review sessions as possible.
