MEMORANDUM FOR MR. PLUMMER

SUBJECT: Meeting with PFIAB Panel

At the right is an information copy of the Memorandum to Dr. Hall which establishes meeting times for you and the other principals to discuss positions to be offered to the PFIAB. We believe that this procedure is at variance with the desires of the PFIAB Panel since it has been clearly requested that individual and not institutional positions be presented. It is recommended that you play your position "close to the vest" until such time as you can determine if an institutional position vis-a-vis the NRP is being created.



Note to Mr. P.

Attached is the note I mentioned yesterday. I cannot stress enough the importance of getting sufficient time to study this and think through your ideas before committing to a position. Your meeting with the Panel probably will have the major bearing on the outcome of the panel's findings. I am having prepared a package (background, recommendations, talking points) and suggest at least a two-hour meeting with the Panel before you meet with the Panel on July 23rd.
