Summary.

Dr. Froehlke held an informal (he sat on his desk) 25-minute meeting on the meaning of his added duties on intelligence assigned by Mr. Laird. Dr. Froehlke emphasized that he would have line responsibility on resource management and staff responsibility for program management. He said he didn't really care whether he had line or staff capacities; his principal concern was his relationship with Laird and Packard. He said he would hardly have time to run the programs.

Dr. Froehlke handed out a chart (attached) which he said represented about one hour's work. He said his deputy ought to be a non-career civil servant or a military man.
