SUBJECT: Ave atque Vale!

It is now almost four years since Drs. McMillan and Seamans signed an agreement to coordinate NASA-NRO earth-sensing matters. Garbarini, and joined Carter, Mazza, and Worthman to carry out, rather informally, the terms of that agreement. Before long, a Survey Applications Coordinating Committee and a Manned Space Flight Policy Committee formalized the McMillan-Seamans arrangement. Since that time the members of SACC have worked their way through a wide variety of matters and, more important, have developed a clearer and more sympathetic understanding of each organization's problems.
