- 1. Reference the subject memorandum, I have just this morning seen it after returning from the trip I departed on Thursday afternoon. I understand that in the light of conversations you have subsequently held with Mr. McCone, the subject memorandum is now of purely academic interest.
- 2. I do want you to know, however, that the memorandum does not conform to my understanding of our discussion Thursday.
- 3. We discussed the seven points you mentioned under FULCRUM, most of which you put forward. I made no agreement of any kind, nor did I commit the Agency or the Director to any course of action.
 - 4. This confirms my oral statement, same date.
