MEMORANDUM TO MR. BUNDY - TO THE PRESIDENT'S BOARD

REFERENCE: Mr. Bundy's memorandum of 7 June, subject:
National Recommaissance Program

"The agreement between CIA and DOD continues as the basic charter. While both of us, CIA and DOD, did as much as possible to insure that no ambiguity or areas of possible conflict were contained in this agreement, its implementation has brought forth certain areas needing clarification.

Most of these areas have now been identified and have been the subject of discussion in the past several weeks between and among Dr. Whelan, General Carter, and myself for CIA, and Dr. McMillan, Dr. Fubini and Mr. Gilpatric for DOD. It is, perhaps, premature at this time to state whether these discussions will bring about a need to revise this agreement. However, in light of the significance of the program to which this agreement addresses itself and your known interest in it, I will insure that you are kept advised of any significant changes that may take place."
