PLEASE INSURE THAT THE ACTIONS YOU ARE TAKING TO IMPLEMENT THE EXTENDED LIFETIME SUPPORT MODULE FOR MOL ARE NOT IN CONFLICT WITH THE GUIDANCE CONTAINED IN THE DRAFT MEMORANDUM. MEMORANDUM FOR THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF THE AIR FORCE (R&D). SUBJECT: EXTENDED LIFETIME SUPPORT MODULE FOR MOL. I HAVE REVIEWED YOUR MEMORANDUM ON THIS SUBJECT DATED 20 JANUARY 1967. I CONCUR IN YOUR APPROACH TO DESIGN THE BASELINE MOL SYSTEM SO THAT A GROWTH TO A 60-DAY LIFE CAN BE ACHIEVED WHEN DESIRED BUT TO QUALIFY THE PRESENT SYSTEM ONLY FOR 30 DAYS. THE MOL PROGRAM WHICH WILL TOTAL OVER \$2 BILLION AS NOW PLANNED PRESENTS SEVERE FUNDING PROBLEMS. IT IS CERTAINLY PRUDENT THAT WE TAKE STEPS SUCH AS YOU PROPOSE WHICH COULD LEAD TO A MORE EFFECTIVE USE OF THE MOL SYSTEM IN THE FUTURE. I DO REQUEST, HOWEVER, THAT SPECIAL STEPS BE TAKEN IN THE CONFIGUARTION AND CHAGE CONTROL AREA TO ASSURE THAT IN PROVIDING FOR A FUTURE EXTENDED LIFE CAPABILITY THE FUNDING REQUIRED FOR CHANGES TO THE BASELINE PROGRAM NOT BE INCREASED BEYOND THE \$2 MILLION YOU IDENTIFY AS NECESSARY. AT SUCH TIME AS COMPONENT EXTENDED LIFE AND OTHER DEVELOPMENT TEST RESULTS WHICH MAY BE NECESSARY ARE AVAILABLE, I WOULD APPRECIATE RECEIVING A BRIEFING SHOWING THE COST OF IMPLEMENTING UNMANNED EXTENDED LIFE MISSIONS COMPARED TO THE OPERATIONAL ADVANTAGES GAINED. UNQUOTE.
