SUBJECT: Redlegation of Procurement Authority

TO: Director, Procurement & Production, MOL

1. Redelegable procurement authorities which are now vested in the undersigned are hereby redelegated to the Director, Procurement & Production, MOL in respect to all MOL projects and programs entered into or administered under the authority of the Deputy Director, MOL as follows:

a. To enter into, approve, and take other actions as required in respect to contracts, change orders, supplemental agreements, awards, letter contracts, leases, and amendments of contractual instruments.

b. This authority is limited to those individual contractual actions having a value of \$350,000.00 or less.

2. Further redelegation is not authorized.

SUMMARY
PROBLEM:

1. Existing general delegations of procurement authority do not clearly establish the propriety of employing AFSC procurement authorities for MOL procurements.

DISCUSSION:

2. The general problem area has been discussed, informally, with Mr. H. L. Repetti, SCKP, and Mr. E. G. Carter, SCJC, both of whom agree that the existing situation with respect to basic procurement authority for MOL should be clarified.

3. Two potential solutions have been considered: (1) Amend (or reissue) the existing delegation of general procurement authority from Hq USAF (DCS/S&L) to the Commander, AFSC, to provide specifically for AFSC procurement support of MOL, or (2) Issue an appropriate redelegation of authority directly from the Assistant Director, MOL (Procurement) to the Deputy Director, MOL, under the authorities delegated in Dr. Brown's memo to Gen Keeling of 20 June 1967.

4. Option (2) above more nearly parallels the action taken by the Assistant Director on 23 June 1967, in connection with a related matter, and is therefore the recommended approach.

RECOMMENDATION:

5. That the attached redelegation of procurement authority be signed.

1. Redelegable procurement authorities which are now vested in the undersigned are hereby redelegated to the Deputy Director, MOL in respect to all MOL projects and programs entered into or administered under the authority of the Assistant Director, MOL (Procurement) as follows:

a. To enter into, approve, and take other action with respect to contracts, change orders, supplemental agreements, awards, letter contracts, leases, and amendments of contractual instruments.

b. This authority is limited to those individual contractual actions having a value of \$5 million or less.

2. Further redelegation may not be made without the express approval of the Assistant Director, MOL (Procurement).
