MEMORANDUM FOR ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF DEFENSE (SYSTEMS ANALYSIS)

SUBJECT: MOL DCP

I have sent you a copy of my memorandum to the Deputy Secretary of Defense resulting from your memo to me, DIA, and the Air Force.

In accordance with our telcon of 31 January 1969. I will discuss your issues prior to the presentation to Mr. Packard and will not critique your paper as requested. You have received Gen. Carroll's brief reply and Dr. Flax has indicated a willingness to participate in our discussion.

It is hoped that the differences between your position and the recommendations of the DIA, the Air Force, and ODDR&E can be resolved at that time. I suggest that you ask Dr. Flax, Gen. Garroll, and Gen. Stewart to join us for this discussion.

Should agreement not be reached, perhaps your issues can be strengthened in the next revision to the MOL DCP.
