Dear Dr. Newell:

In my April 20, 1970 letter I proposed a general approach for the transfer of the MOL Acquisition and Tracking Scope, Mission Development Simulator and Drive A System. During our May meeting we had discussed storing some of these items until your future plans for their use were more definitive. Having now reviewed our options, it appears that the best course of action is to surface immediately and transfer these items to NASA. In this way, a NASA history and documentation will be available when SKYLAB II becomes a reality.

Working together, our staffs have prepared the attached plan to effect the transfer action We have reviewed the internal NASA transfer instructions to supplement the plan and found them in accord with our stated objectives.

I anticipate that the actual transfer of equipments will be completed in the very near future.
