I recall our conversation of 29 September regarding security precautions at the Advanced Projects Facility and the subsequent review within CIA of the report that you make reference to in your memorandum of 9 November. I chose at that time not to comment, as there seemed to be agreement as to the relatively minor changes required. However, I hereby concur in the recommended security revisions contained in the attachment to your memorandum.

Additionally, it is explicitly understood that this modification does not set a precedent for other CIA programs nor does it affect the current discussion of CIA participation in various portions of the COMINT program.
