SUBJECT : AADC's Part in Project CORONA

REFERENCE : [REDACTED] dated 3 November 1958

1. You will recall our conference on 3 November concerning the need for CORONA clearances of certain individuals within Headquarters, AADC, raised by Colonel Sheppard from HQ. At that time, it was agreed it should be discussed with General Donald Flickinger and an indication given to him of our desire for this issue being raised with General Anderson. It was hoped the list could be firmly established and surplus personnel deleted; and that those remaining would be given a strong security briefing regarding CORONA.

2. On 11 November, [REDACTED] and I met with General Flickinger and thoroughly reviewed this subject. He agreed to discuss the matter with General Anderson. On 12 November, General Flickinger spoke with General Anderson and found him in complete sympathy with our objectives. General Anderson indicated he felt the following should be the only personnel in AADC Headquarters cleared for CORONA:
