


EMPLIED FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Trip Report, 12-13 October 1958 (ASS Headquarters, Scott AFR, Illinois)

- 1. On 12 October 1958 the undersigned visited the Air Neather Service Headquarters, Scott Air Force Pass, Illinois, to discuss various matters of interest to Projects and CORONA.
- Project COROMA. This briefing had been requested by Community Mis, and approved by the MFS Security Staff. Appropriate forms were executed by Community and he was permitted to review the COROMA briefing folder. This was followed by a verbal briefing on the present status of Project COROMA, including the preparation of a suitable cover story.
