SUBJECT: Clarification - [REDACTED]

1. Ref. [REDACTED] - [REDACTED] - "CORONA Operations" is a poor choice of words denoting exploitation procedures at [REDACTED] in the handling of CORONA take. Periodic eyeball-to-eyeball meetings between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are important because of the voluminous material that pass between them during and after any CORONA mission, the requirement for frequent changes in these data, and the necessity for correctness.

2. Ref. [REDACTED] Re: Univac 1004 at [REDACTED] - The 1004 at [REDACTED] will be needed as long as the stored program tape is cut at that location. The 1004 link between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] knocks about two days off the time it takes to prepare, punch, verify, and certify flight tape. The tape punching machinery is located at VAFB. Although bought by CORONA program, they are used by other programs on a non-interference basis. This was used as one of the negating arguments when I proposed some time ago that the machines be brought to [REDACTED] and put on-line with the computer that developed the program. After losing there I asked [REDACTED] to survey the market place for improved tape punching machines and send us ROM costs. That was about a year ago. They haven't got around to it yet.

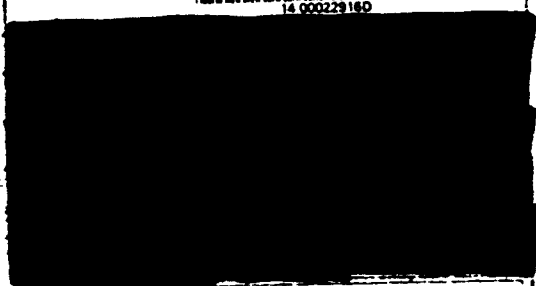

1. REQUEST [redacted] APPROVAL FOR [redacted], UNIVAC REPRESENTATIVE AT VAFB.
2. AT PRESENT UNIVAC 1004 MAINTENANCE IS ACCOMPLISHED BY TWO REPRESENTATIVES FROM UNIVAC IN LOS ANGELES. MAINTENANCE BY THESE REPS IS PROVIDED ON A MONTHLY BASIS OR AS REQUIRED IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS. IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS, [redacted] HAS EXPERIENCED A DELAY OF SIX TO EIGHT HOURS BEFORE ONE OF THE L.A. REPS "ARRIVED ON THE SCENE."
