MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Trip Report, 12-13 October 1958
(SSS Headquarters, Scott AFB, Illinois)

1. On 12 October 1958 the undersigned visited the Air Weather Service Headquarters, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois, to discuss various matters of interest to Projects [redacted] and CORONA.
2. On this occasion the writer briefed [redacted] on Project CORONA. This briefing had been requested by [redacted], Commander SSS, and approved by the SPS Security Staff. Appropriate forms were executed by [redacted] and he was permitted to review the CORONA briefing folder. This was followed by a verbal briefing on the present status of Project CORONA, including the preparation of a suitable cover story. [redacted] will be involved in the weather prediction activity for the launch and recovery areas and will be directly responsible for making necessary forecast arrangements, including the coordination of such efforts within the Air Weather Service Headquarters. His task will be to service Project CORONA in a manner that will appear completely overt within his own headquarters.
3. The balance of the time was spent in discussions with [redacted] and [redacted] whose appearance followed the briefing of [redacted]. The latest pictures of Typhoons Winnie and Ida were shown to those present and all displayed extreme interest in the photographic details of storm areas. [redacted] was extremely interested in having mosaic reprints made available to Life magazine, who apparently are continuing their efforts toward a tropical cyclone series beginning in November. It was agreed that every effort would be made to prepare such mosaics as soon as possible and to forward the completed negatives to Air Weather Service Headquarters, who will in turn forward same to the Life magazine science editor.
