CORONA.

1. The integration of someone in ARPA was not agreeable to Mr. Bissell. It was recommended that liaison be conducted with ARPA and Mr. Parangosky was named as the liaison officer. An ARPA representative at CORONA meetings was still considered a good idea according to Mr. Kucera. Col. Sheppard has objections to [REDACTED] and Mr. Kucera are to discuss this aspect.

2. Firings are scheduled for 3 and 19 June and 6 and 16 July. It was not finally decided whether destruction devices would be recommended.
