(1) What should be set aside?

Preferably, <sup>full-scale engineering</sup> a development model or mock-up not intended to fly -  
A major piece of hardware from each program should be identified ~~for~~ for long-term storage & retention.

(2) How we should acquire the articles

- should talk w/ every Program Director to ascertain now what should be saved; to alert them to keep an eye out for the appropriate items (and all related hardware, ground support equipment & containers).
