1. The undersigned concurred in the procurement of a twin MURAL carrier case container (in addition to the one available from the COMCHA program) to provide a choice and flexibility, if desired, in the courier transport of the MURAL product. Hence, the capability now exists either to transport, in an appropriate carrier case, the MURAL product as a unit or in a split shipment, if desired, to provide maximum safety and added assurance that all will not be lost in the event of a serious mishap while the raw original take is being transported to [Redacted]. The twin MURAL carrier case was available for use prior to the first MURAL firing.

2. The delay in giving Lt. Col. Murphy a clear cut decision to procure the twin MURAL carrier case was due to the failure of the undersigned to make up his mind promptly in this matter.
