1. AFTER BLOSSOM TIME (CHUTE DEPLOYMENT) A JC-54, NORTH OF CHRISTMAS ISLAND, RECEIVED A T/M SIGNAL FROM THE CAPSULE BUT WAS MABLE TO OBTAIN ON BEARING. THE SIGNAL WAS HELD FOR 25 NINUTES. HE AREA OF THE JC-54 MATCHED THE IMPACT AREA INDICATED BY POST REENTRY COMPUTATIONS BASED ON AND TRACKING INFO.

- 2. ANOTHER JC-54 WAS DIRECTED TO THE AREA. BOTH AIRCRAFT RE-CEIVED SIGNALS FROM THE G.E. BEACON AND REPORTED A VISUAL SIGHTING AT 0440Z AT THE PRESENT TIME BOTH A/C ARE CIRCULING THE AREA. AREA IS 0505N 15914H
 - 3. PLANS FOR RECOVERY ARE AS FOLLOWS:
- A C-130 WILL DEPART SOR THE AREA AND DROP A RATU (MARKER BEACON),
