Forecast Activities:

- 1. The ITEK monthly report for April, ITEK cost proposal for post flight evaluation, and EKIT report No. "Response of SO-121 Color at Solar Angles Less Than 30% recalled for change in classification and recirculation, will arrive at Headquarters on 23 May 1965.
