The following arrangements have been made for handling the visitors scheduled to attend the PG Meeting on 23 January 1967:

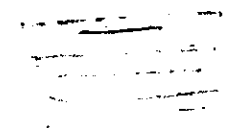
- A. Arrangements were made through OSP Security to reserve fifteen parking spaces in the visitor parking area at the main entrance for the entire day of 23 January 1967.

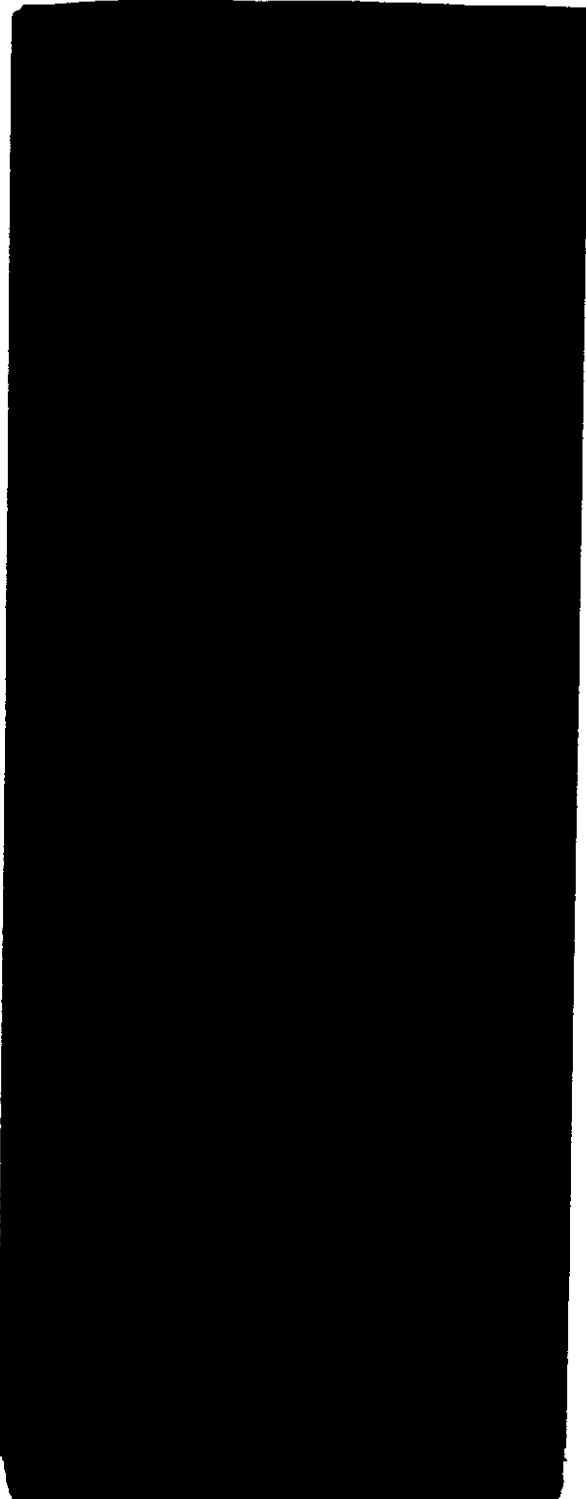
