MEMORANDUM FOR: Director, Office of Special Projects

SUBJECT: CORONA Weekly Report, 24-28 April

1. Webb conducting buy off inspection of instruments 304/305 on 27 April and instruments 220/221 on 28 April at ITEK, Boston.
2. The "C" Operational Schedule was transferred to the stationary panel on Thursday.
3. A set of polaroid pictures including all "C" information displayed, with the exception of the PERT chart, was hand carried to A/P by [REDACTED] on 26 April 1967.
4. Two EKIT flights were scheduled for 24 and 25 April. These two flights fall in the category of Missile Launch Detection and specifically are a comparison of SO-180 vs. 3404 and SO-180 vs. SO-121. A third flight in support of this test was cancelled by [REDACTED]. The Bicolor test will consist of two flights, one with cyan and orange filters and the other with red and green filters. The above flights, including the one cancelled, account for the five flights referred to in the Monday briefing; however, only two of the three tests noted on the EKIT schedule chart are considered. The other flight test scheduled for April is a flight with SO-230 being flown by EK. ITEK is doing only analysis of SO-230. The EKIT chart has been corrected.
