General Carter,

The facts about our conversation reported in your draft memorandum for record of 25 March are correct as I remember it. The memorandum omits reference to an exchange in which, after some discussion, you agreed, I believe, that it was Crowley's judgment which would determine what information was to be released to General Greer's people.

Your inference that I was West for the launch of 1018 is not correct. I was in Los Angeles on another matter.

Subsequent to our call, as you will remember, I have determined and reported to you that the two malfunctions mentioned in your memorandum were reported to General Greer's people. There was an indicated malfunction in the power system of the Agena, observed by Gen. Greer's people, which could have related to problems in the payload. This was one of the two difficulties I was referring to in our conversation.
