MEMORANDUM FOR AFSP

SUBJECT: Request for Removal of Materials

This memorandum responds to your request for a formal statement of our requirement for removal of material produced at Kawecki-Berylco, Hazelton, Pennsylvania.

Kawecki-Berylco is producing several beryllium sheets for Hughes Aircraft Company for shipment to Republic Aviation, Farmingdale, L. I., New York for subsequent fabrication. It is our understanding that the prospects for a near-term settlement of the strike at Berylco are not good; therefore, we request your assistance in obtaining the removal of the following materials:


