

SUBJECT: Review of Congressional Statements and Testimony

Some recent events have occurred which have caused concern that the security and policy review of Congressional Statements and Testimony is not sufficiently sensitive to national policy regarding space activities. In order to preclude the inadvertent disclosure of sensitive information involving space programs, I would like for my Staff to have the opportunity to review prepared statements prior to their presentation to Congress and also the resulting testimony prior to printing it in the Congressional Record. The subject areas of interest include all matters pertaining to space with particular emphasis on space systems, boosters, satellites and space shuttle efforts.

I would appreciate it if you would identify someone from your office whom we can contact to arrange for initiating this review process.

I would be glad to discuss this further should you wish; however, I would appreciate your support at this time.
