



THE NRP ORGANIZATIONAL ENVIRONMENT






SECRETARY OF DEFENSE ULTIMATELY RESPONSIBLE FOR MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION OF NRO AND NRP





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THE NRP ORGANIZATIONAL ENVIRONMENT






MISSION

SAFSP IS A FUNCTIONAL ELEMENT OF THE NATIONAL RECONNAISSANCE OFFICE (NRO), A COVERT ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO THE OVERFLIGHT COLLECTION OF INTELLIGENCE FROM DENIED AREAS OF THE WORLD. SAFSP'S FUNCTION IS TO DEVELOP, LAUNCH AND OPERATE SATELLITE RECONNAISSANCE PROGRAMS. NATIONAL POLICY DICTATES THAT SUCH OPERATIONS WILL BE CONDUCTED UNDER SPECIAL COVERT CONTROLS TO AVOID DIPLOMATIC CONFRONTATION OR OTHER UNFAVORABLE INTERNATIONAL OF DOMESTIC REACTION.

THE MISSION OF SAFSP-3 IS TO PROVIDE THE NECESSARY ENVIRONMENT AND METHODS AND TO DIRECT THE SECURITY ASPECTS OF ALL COVERT OPERATIONS UNDER THE DIRECTOR, SAFSP.

- * RECEIVES, CONTROLS AND DISTRIBUTES APPROXIMATELY 25,000 BYEMAN HARD COPY PER YEAR -- (20,000 IN -- 5,000 OUT)
- * RECEIVES, CONTROLS AND DISTRIBUTES APPROXIMATELY 30,000 MESSAGES PER YEAR (23,000 IN AND 7,000 OUT)
- RECEIVES, CONTROLS AND STORES APPROXIMATELY 1,200 SI/TK DOCUMENTS A YEAR
