SUBJECT: Guidelines for Sanitizing and Handling of KH-4
Materials for NATO Air Crews

The following interim guidelines apply to the preparation and handling of sanitized KH-4 materials for use by NATO air crews for strike of active NATO targets. Other use of materials sanitized for this purpose by persons who are not cleared for access to TALENT-KEYHOLE (T-KH) information is strictly prohibited.

## General

- 1. All sanitization of KH-4 materials will be by T-KH cleared personnel and only in T-KH approved facilities.
- 2. There will be no attribution of sanitized materials to any source, either satellite reconnaissance or notional source.
- 3. There will be no reference to nor acknowledgement of T-KH systems or satellite reconnaissance in discussions with NATO air crews.
- 4. Sanitized photography will not be carried in aircraft except in execution of war plans.

- 5. Distribution to and use of sanitized photography is authorized only for necessary staff and operations personnel specifically engaged in NATO target weapons delivery preparations. Need-to-know will govern.
  - 6. Only partial frames will be used.
- 7. Photography will be altered by enlargement of and change of original scale and removal of the original fiducial marks.
- 8. All compartmented TALENT-KEYHOLE markings and identification of original mission will be removed.
  - 9. Date may be indicated by month and year.
- 10. All sanitized prints will be classified NATO SECRET, LIMITED DISTRIBUTION, NO REPRODUCTION PERMITTED.
- 11. Only the minimum number of copies of individual prints will be made to satisfy required use.
- 12. Reproduction of sanitized prints outside TALENT-KEYHOLE centers is not permitted.
- 13. The Director, DIA is authorized to establish appropriate procedures for physical control and reporting on all KH-4 materials sanitized in accordance with these guidelines.
