(U//~~FOUO~~) The National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) Office of Inspector General (OIG) completed an investigation of [redacted] (Social Security [redacted]), a [redacted]

[redacted] software engineer in [redacted] for violation of 18 USC § 287, *False, Fictitious, and Fraudulent Claims*.

(U//~~FOUO~~) [redacted] supported NRO contract [redacted]. The investigation revealed 74 hours inappropriately charged by [redacted] to the NRO contract from January 2010 to April 2010. [redacted] was unable to explain why his hours were charged incorrectly.

(U//~~FOUO~~) [redacted] terminated [redacted] employment. He was debriefed of his NRO clearances and the company credited \$7,696 to the NRO contract. The OIG considers the company's effort sufficient and the case was settled administratively.
