

SUBJECT: HEXAGON (Mission 1220) Launch Failure

On 18 April 1986 at 1345 EST, HEXAGON Mission 1220 was launched from SLC-4E at Vandenberg, AFB using a Titan booster. An explosion occurred seconds after lift-off and the command to destruct was issued at approximately 10 seconds after lift-off. The mission also carried the P-989 Mission 7242, LORRI II, an EHF Search and VHF Technical Intelligence pallet.
