THE APPROXIMATE COORDINATES OF THE IMPACT POSITION ARE 15 DEGREES 56' S = 141 DEGREES 49" E. DESCRIPTION: METAL SPHERE W/23 1/2" OUTSIDE DIAMETER. WALL THICKNESS SMM. WEIGHT 61 LBS. MADE IN TWO HALVES JOINED TOGETHER WITH WELD. TWO METAL PROTRUSIONS OPPOSITE SIDES. SERIES OF NUMBERS OF WHICH 906807 DECIPHERABLE. (THE NUMBER / IS IDENTIFIABLE AS AMERICAN AND NOT EUROPEAN). DEJECT NUW PACKED IN WOUDEN SHIPPING CRATE, SIZE APPROXIMATELY 15 CU. FT., WEIGHT 146 LBS. B) MOUROUBRA DEBRIS - LATE IN JANUARY 1973 A SPACE VEHICLE COMPONENT WAS DISCOVERED ON THE SHORE OF LAKE MOURE IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA (APPROXIMATELY 3006GREES S = 11 UDEGREES 48 F E).
