# INTERESPORTABILITAL COVER SUPPORT TO OPERATION NUMBUS

#### L. PREVIOUS COVER PLAN

This document supersedes previous Cover Plan BYE 3401-62 which should be removed from the files and destroyed.

### II. OPERATIONAL OBJECTIVE

The objective of Operation MMENTS is photographic and electronic reconnaissance of selected military and intelligence targets on the island of Cubs. The instrument to be used to accomplish the objective is the U-3 sircraft.

#### UL General operational cover plan

During recent months, the United States has intensified its surveillance of the whole Caribbans area in order to acquire up-to-the-minute information on the nature and extent of the communist buildup. The Strategic Air Command is flying normal surveillance missions in support of this objective, using U-2 nireraft.

The above plan principally applies when the U-2 is located, or involved in an incident, outside the U.S. continental limits. For training/staging base activities and for emergency landings at bases within the continental United States, there is an alternate story as indicated in paragraphs V. B. and C below.

# V. PERTMENT COVER STORIES TO BE DISSEMINATED BY RESPONSIBLE ACTION OFFICES ARE INDICATED BELOW:

# A. General Press and Publication Inquiries:

#### 1. Cover Story

s. In the event of an incident, the Department of State spokesman, in response to queries at press conforences, will refer to the final communique of the Informal Meeting of Ministers of Foreign Affairs of the American Republics which was held in Washington on October 2 and 3, 1963, which reads in pertinent part as follows:

"The meeting observed that it is desirable to intensify surveillance of the delivery of arms and implements of war and all other items of strategic importance to the Communist regime in Cuba, in order to prevent the secret accumulation in the island of arms that can be used for offensive purposes against the Esmisphere."

He will state that in response to this OAS agreement the United States has intensified its surveillance through the use of every means available to the nation to acquire upto-the-minute information on the nature and extent of the communist buildup in Cuba.

b. CINCLANT will be advised of the foregoing and instructed to refer any press inquiries to the Director. Cifice of Information, Headquesters, USAF (General Mertin). The Under Secretary of the Air Force (Dr Charyk) will furnish to General Martin a statement consistent with paragraph a. above.

within emergency landing distance of the Guantzaamo Haval Ease he will head offshore, contact the base by prearranged signal, which will acramble a fighter escert, and land at Guantzaamo from the direction of the open sea.

If he falls into the hands of Castro forces, he will repeat the story given in paragraph V. E., balow. If queried by these forces, he may state that he was engaged in paripheral surveillance, but will deny overflight. In response to questions regarding his physical presence in Cube, he will state that he was attacked while on a regular peripheral surveillance mission, parachuted from his sircraft, and drifted inland.

In the event of an incident verified by appropriate U. S. authorities, the Department of State spokesmen, without awaiting a protest from Cuban sources, will use the cover story in V. A. 1. and vigorously protest Cuban action against a legitimate peripheral surveillance flight.
