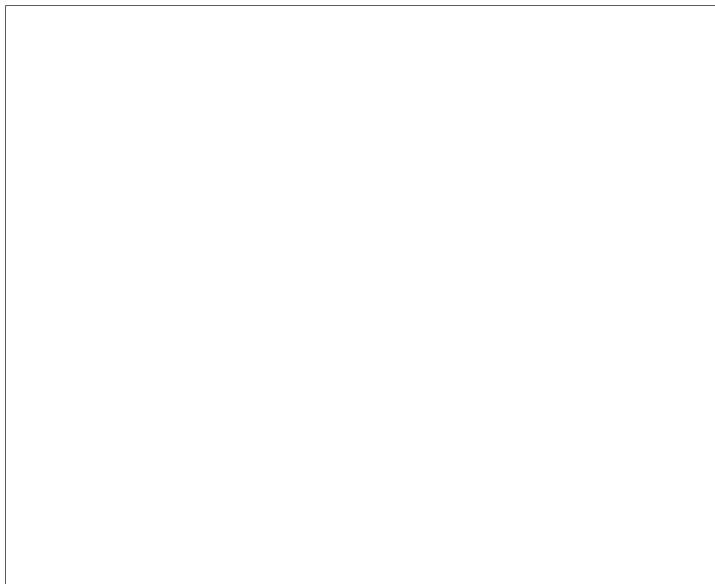

Both [Redacted] and [Redacted] were successfully briefed SCI by Army security at Fort Belvoir under the NV contract with all necessary accesses (all 4) to meet the entrance and badging requirements for Westfields and the JCC.

Now that they are briefed SCI our plan is to have the Army SSO at Belvoir submit a perm cert for 1 year for both [Redacted] and [Redacted]. I will work with [Redacted] to get the right SMO code for the Army SSO to send the perm cert via JPAS but also verify this is how Westfields wants it done.

Once the perm cert is sent and in place for both [Redacted] and [Redacted] we will need your support and approval for both an IC badge and NMIS and UMIS accounts.

Need your help.....
[Redacted] is the [Redacted] for ACES deployment to the NROC. As you know, WE are trying to move forward on working off the POA&M Liens so ACES can proceed out of IOC and pursue FOC status. I understand we have some administrative issues with MOD Security that has us insisting that DoD (HQ AF) do all clearance adjudications or SCI read-ins because they hold the contract for this effort. While ACES is an active and important program to us, I don't believe the DoD (AF) will be very responsive to our immediate need.
I'm told this is [Redacted] history and his current clearance status.....

- 1) [Redacted] has a TS with SSBI from July 2010 (he is an Air Force Reservist)
- 2) He was subsequently read into SI/TK in July 2010 with the 909 SOW
- 3) In 2013, he transferred to the 908 Airlift Wing (where he still had a TS/SCI)
- 4) In July 2015, [Redacted] 5-year reinvestigation was never completed so he was administratively debriefed from SCI and reverted back to a Secret clearance
- 5) In Nov 2015, [Redacted] joined Lockheed where he was read into Collateral SCI which is his current clearance

What can we (NROC) do to get [Redacted] read-into SCI and on-boarded into APICS or badged.....assuming he has no issues within the past two years??
