In a sense, this new membership is not approved until Dr. McLucas and Mr. Packard approve the newly revised Satellite Contingency Plan.

In preparing this new membership list, the ICPC Working Group did not consciously exclude Colonel Hartley. Instead, the Working Group reviewed the matter from an organizational standpoint and reflected in the new list those organizations which they felt should be represented. As it turned out, the new list added ASD/PA in an advisory capacity and left off Colonel Hartley.

If one considers the people who have functional responsibility when a contingency arises, I think the present list is correct. OSD/PA must understand and execute its role. Individuals in elements such as SAFSP, CIA/OSP, Program D, and the USAF-147/154 office do not have the same sort of functional roles as the ICPC Members.

Individuals in SAFSP, CIA/OSP and Program D participated in preparing, reviewing and coordinating those contingency plans which pertained to their particular programs.

I think we have the right membership now. It has been muddled in the past, and that is what we have been anxious to clarify.
