(S//ST/TR//NF) The NRO continues to support military intelligence integration efforts through baseline tools, There are also on-going efforts to develop new solutions to intelligence integration requirements for the Combatant Commands and the Intelligence Community. The NRO has executed DNI guidance for sharing national intelligence for the RUS-UKR Crisis by pushing sanitized and downgraded intelligence	(b)(1) (b)(3)
Finally, the NRO and are helping to augment an unclassified Air Common Operating Picture with unclassified data feeds. (S//NF) In addition, please identify areas where you have accepted risk in order to surge for the crisis and how long you can reasonably expect to maintain current surge levels.	
(\$//TK//NF) The NRO will continue to support RUS-UKR crisis requirements and maintain its current posture, as required. There are resourcing constraints that will have to be addressed if the current posture is to be enduring. If escalation were to occur, the protection and defense requirements to provide mission assurance will expand. With the current reliance on overhead ISR to provide safe standoff for traditional U.S. ISR assets, the NRO will continue to surge to meet customer demands and ultimately provide critical intelligence to our mission partners and allies.
