## MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

On October 2 Mr. Jim McDonaid called to ask our assistance	
in providing DCAS QA type support for some of his contractual	
effort, spec <u>ifically at</u>	and PE. Danbury on
HEXAGON.	

On the latter requirement, we determined that the DCAS support in that geographical area is under the cognizance of the Hartford office of the Boston division. I asked Mr. McDonald to provide us with certain items of information which were necessary in our arranging the DCAS support. These were: (1) the number of manhours per month required, (2) any special talents required, i.e., optical, electrical and the like, (3) an estimate of overtime required, and (4) the desired starting date. I assured Mr. McDonald that it could be arranged at DCAS and that the security question could be resolved once we were able to obtain from DCAS their candidates for this job. I further assured Mr. McDonald that he would have no difficulty with the inbetween echelons of DCAS since we would ask our cleared director, DCAS, in the Washington area to arrange the secure handling of this support. Mr. McDonald was to call me back with this information.
