AS WE APPROACH THE LAUNCH OF THE [REDACTED] AND HEXAGON
PROGRAMS WE DO SO WITH ONE OF THE POOREST SECURITY TRACK
RECORDS IN RECENT YEARS. UNLESS WE EXERT ALL POSSIBLE
EFFORT TO MINIMIZE OR PREVENT ANY FURTHER DISLOCATES,
WE WILL BE FACED WITH SIGNIFICANT COMPROMISE OF THESE
PROGRAMS.

WE CANNOT RELY ON "STANDARD PROCEDURES" TO OFFER THE
PROTECTION WE DESIRE FOR THESE TWO INITIAL LAUNCHES. THE
ONLY WAY WE CAN HOPE TO PROTECT THE LAUNCHES IS WITH
COMPLETE REVIEW OF ALL PROCEDURES, BOTH BLACK AND WHITE;

IF KNOWLEDGEABLE OF ALL DETAILS, CORRECTING THOSE THAT ARE
INADEQUATE; AND BY MAINTAINING ABSOLUTE RIGID DISCIPLINE
BY ALL PARTICIPANTS, AND INSURING THEY UNDERSTAND AND
APPRECIATE THESE RESTRAINTS AND THE REASONS FOR THEM.

IN VIEW OF THE INFORMATION THAT HAS REACHED THE
PUBLIC DOMAIN, THE QUESTION IS: HOW DO WE PREVENT ITS
BEING NOTICED - AND - IF IT IS, HOW DO WE MINIMIZE THE
SPLIT IMAGE?

ONE OF THE MOST APPARENT ANSWERS IS THAT, IF POSSIBLE,
WE AVOID IMMEDIATE ASSOCIATION OF [REDACTED]
AMT 967, PERKIN ELMER,
ET AL ON THE SECOND. WE DO HAVE AN ENVIRABLE RECORD FOR
SUCCESSFULLY LAUNCHING FROM KENNEDY UNDER THE WORST OF
CIRCUMSTANCES, AND "GETTING AWAY WITH IT." IT IS THEREFORE

RECOMMENDED THAT IN ADDITION TO PROCEDURES ALREADY INITIATED AT VANDENBERG, THAT THOSE SPECIAL PROCEDURES, AND LESSONS LEARNED AT THE CAPE BE IMMEDIATELY APPLIED FOR THESE LAUNCHES. IN ADDITION, THE USE OF THE NUMBERS OF [REDACTED] 467 SHOULD BE MINIMIZED OR ELIMINATED IN CONNECTION WITH THE LAUNCHES.

OTHER MAJOR ITEMS THAT IMMEDIATELY OCCUR TO US FOR CONSIDERATION ARE:

1. CONTROL OF PERSONNEL MOVEMENTS TO AND FROM THE LAUNCH, AND OF PERSONNEL ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE VANDENBERG, SHINVALE, AND CONTRACTOR AREAS. PUBLIC EXPOSURE MUST BE MINIMIZED FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS.
 2. ALL ACTIVITIES SHOULD BE PUNCHED TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE TO AVOID TELLTALE HIGHLIGHTING OF PROCEDURES.
 3. WHILE WE DO NOT WANT "OUTSIDERS" TO RECOGNIZE THAT THERE IS SPECIAL ACTIVITY OF CONCERN, THOSE PERSONNEL INVOLVED IN THE PROGRAM, EITHER BYCIRAN OR DOD, MUST BE MADE TO REALIZE THAT THESE LAUNCHES ARE NOT ONLY SPECIAL, BUT THEY ARE CRITICAL TO THE NATIONAL DEFENSE. THEY MUST BE CONVINCED THAT THEY AND THEY ALONE MAY INFLUENCE THE SUCCESS OF THE MISSION.
 4. IF NOT ALREADY DONE; THE TOP LEVEL PERSONNEL PARTICIPATING IN THESE LAUNCHES MUST BE FORTINALLY MADE AWARE OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES AND POSSIBLE RAMIFICATIONS OF FAILURE.
- TIME IS CRITICAL FOR [REDACTED] AND WILL BE A MAJOR LIMITING FACTOR; AND IS ALMOST AS CRITICAL FOR HEXAGOS.

IT IS OUR RECOMMENDATION THAT THE FIRST WEEK OF MARCH BE UTILIZED TO DETERMINE PRECISE STATUS, WHAT MUST BE DONE, AND INITIATION OF ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN. DURING THE SECOND WEEK OF MARCH IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT OUR STAFF JOIN YOURS IN A COMPLETE WALK THROUGH AND REVIEW OF PROCEDURES IN ORDER TO INSURE THAT ALL POSSIBLE ACTIONS HAVE BEEN CONSIDERED AND ACCOMPLISHED. WE ARE PREPARED TO OFFER ANY AND ALL ASSISTANCE, AND CONSIDERATION SHOULD BE GIVEN TO PILOT PARTICIPATION TO INSURE THAT ALL EXPERTISE AVAILABLE IS FULLY UTILIZED.
