Dear Brock:

I have your memorandum of 29 September 1964 bearing on the FULCRUM Program. We are proceeding according to the plan of 31 August 1964 which was forwarded to Mr. Vance on 1 September 1964 by Mr. McCone with the indication he had approved this procedure and considered it consistent with the agreement reached on 18 August 1964. Your memorandum refers to a meeting of 11 August 1964 which may explain the difference. In any case, our actions taken thus far and planned are completely consistent with the basic document.

Now that much of the arrangement making has been accomplished, we are beginning to see the first real technical progress, and I should like to schedule a briefing for you in the near future. I know that you will be exceedingly pleased by the enormous progress that has been made in launching the FULCRUM Program.
