## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

On 21 October, I called Dr. Wheelon and asked whether the DCI had made any determination about incorporating technical direction language into the FULCRUM systems engineering contract. Dr. Wheelon stated that if we had the impression the Director was considering such a move, we were mistaken. He stated that they have absolutely no intention of incorporating technical direction in the way he and I understand the term.

He questioned whether General Greer uses Aerospace Corp. for technical direction in the way that is now being discussed for FULCRUM. I pointed out that the present work statement on the Aerospace contract for Program 206 calls for subsystem analyses and analyzing of trade-offs between subsystems to optimize performance, and imposes upon Aerospace a contractual responsibility to develop a consistent over-all system description and specification. I said that it was our desire that the SE/TD contractor for FULCRUM studies have a similar responsibility to propose a coherent system concept.
