MEMORANDUM FOR General Stewart

SUBJECT: Wheelon Directive to Lt Colonel Webb

About mid-afternoon today, Dr. Wheelon called. He wanted particularly to talk to you; in your absence he asked for me. He expressed his concern over the "torrent of directives" flooding Lt Col Webb, most of which are coming from "your office." Lt Col Webb doesn't know what to do or where to turn, in the face of so much (and often conflicting) guidance. Much of the confusion results from the fact that the "C management matter is - unfortunately - not settled as yet."

In order to correct this very bad situation Dr. Wheelon announced that he is directing Lt Col Webb to accept Mr. Crowley's word and his word only, for authentication of technical matters. Lt Col Webb is to look to Mr. Dulac, of course, for operational guidance. As regards anyone else "he is to turn off his telephone."
