

MEMORANDUM FOR DR. McLUCAS

SUBJECT: Briefing to Secretary Rogers

On Friday, November 13, we held a dry run of the presentations to Secretary Rogers in Mr. Morrison's office. The presentation we have prepared for you meshes very nicely in content with that prepared by Mr. John Hughes for DIA. He has volunteered to make his viewgraphs available to you should you care to run through them. The DIA presentation talks about satisfaction of photographic requirements and gives examples of good and bad coverage. The entire presentation is on viewgraphs. General Bennett will be out of town and General Philpott will give the DIA presentation. Admiral Gayler has chosen to prepare his own presentation and his representative was unable to tell us its content.

As a result of the dry run, I have incorporated several suggestions into your presentation. I have shown them in the attached book by lining through the existing words and by making additions. Six pages are affected and the changes are relatively minor. Also attached for your use are a set of viewgraphs showing NRO hardware, and a note book showing the same hardware but including brief descriptions.
