
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



Secretary of Defense and the Director of Central Intelligence

Responsibilities of the National Resonationace Office (75)

Definitions

MRO - National Recommissance Office

MRP - Malenel Reconnelecture Program, to consist of all evert and covert satellite and everflight projects for intelligence, geodesy and mapping photography and electronic signal collection.

DNRO - Director, Matienal Reconniscence Office

The following pian cuttines besic policy for the establishment of functions and responsibilities within the Notional Recommissance Office to insure that the particular talents, experience and capabilities within the Department of Defence and the Central Intelligence Agency are fally and most effectively utilised in the establishment, management and conduct of the National Reconnaissance Fregram. The CNRO will be designated by the Secretary of Defence and the Director of Central Intelligence, and will be responsible directly to them for the restagement and conduct of the NRP.

1. Requirements and Priorities:

The NRO will be directly responsive to, and only to, the istographic and electronic signal (SIGINT) collection requirements

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
and priorities established by the United States Intelligence Beard and will develop the ever-all reconnaissance program to satisfy these remirements.

- a. The technical management responsibility for all the MRP is assigned to the DNRO. Under this over-all responsibility for MRP. BOLLO will utilise existing resources in the following manner:
- (1) GIA will be the Ensentive Agent for DMRO for those covert projects already under its management and such additional covert projects as are assigned to it by the Secretary of Defense and the Director of Control Intelligence.
- (2) To provide for full use of evallable canabilities and recoverees, and to provide for interface with data exploitation equipment development by agencies extends the NRO, personnel of Army, Navy, Air Perse, and ClA, will be assigned, on a full-time backs, to appropriate positions within the KRO under the DKRO.
- (5) A firm linious channel between the NRO and the MIA will be established as an adjunct to the technical management etresture of alguel callection projects, and the conduct of such projects carried out in accordance with the emiotypien responsibilities of the MEA.
- (4) Planning will encourage maximum willingtion of the technical and operational resources of the DCB, the Army, Novy. Air Force, NEA, and the GEA to support all collection programs, including, but not Healted to, electronic classi and photographic collection programs,

(1) The MRD will be responsible for funding the MRP. DOD funds will be allocated as an individual project basic and will appear as appropriately chaotifed line stome in the Air Force budget, CEA will be responsible for facility covers projects for which at / has messagement responsibility under passagraph 2 a.(1) shove.




Handle vil Cantrol System (2) DNRO will have responsibility for all NRP contracts in accordance with the assignment of technical management responsibility in paragraph 2. a. Consistent with paragraph 2 a. (1). CIA will be the Executive Agent of the DNRO, responsible for administering procurement and contracting for covert projects for which it is assigned responsibility under paragraph 2. a. (1), and for covert contracting necessary for the support of evert projects.

1. Security:

In accordance with the basic responsibility of the Director of Control Intelligence for protection of intelligence sources and methods, CIA will establish security policy for the NRP, including provision for a uniform system of security control and appropriate delegations of security responsibility.

4. Operations:

- a. Scheduling: The mission schedule for all NRP efforts will be the sole responsibility of DNRO, subject to coordination with: CIA on covert projects for which it is Executive Agent and the note...ing of appropriate clearances where required from higher authority. Operational control for individual projects under the NRP will be assigned to the DOD or to the CIA by the DNRO in accordance with policy guidance from the Secretary of Defense and the Director of Control Intelligence. DNRO will be responsible to assure that intention planning will make full use of all intelligence available in the community.
- h. <u>Permat</u>: The DNRO will be responsible for the format of the collected MRP product as follows:
- (1) Photographic format will include the initial chemical proceeding, titling, production and delivery to the users as specified by the USIB.
- (2) Electronic signal data formet will include the decommutation, conversion, technical correction and reconstruction of the collected signal data to yield a usable collection product. DNRO will deliver the collection product in proper format together with accordated data necessary for exploitation, to the NSA or other user as specified by the USB.



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- c. <u>Engineering Analysis</u>: The DNRO will be responsible for engineering analysis of all collection systems to correct the problems that exist on the operating system as well as to provide information for new systems. In examettion with covert projects for which CIA is Executive Agent, this responsibility will be carried out under the supervision of CIA.
- 5. The DNRO is responsible for advanced plans (nest CY-1764) in support of the NRP. In view of the DCI's major responsibility to the NBC for all intelligence programs, all NRO advanced planning will be coordinated with CIA.
- 6. Public releases of information will be the responsibility of the BNEO subject to the security guidance of CIA.
- 7. The Deputy Director (Research), CIA, will be responsible for seeing that the participation of CIA in this Agreement is carried out.
