ANALYSIS OF EXECUTIVE ORDER OF 18 FEBRUARY 1976

The Executive Order revising the United States Foreign
Intelligence Community raises numerous questions of concern
to the NRO. The following items are broken down into two
categories: those requiring action, and those which requires
definition or answers before we can determine whether or not
action is needed.

The Executive Order strengthens the position of the NRO.

It is the strongest endorsement ever offered to the Intelligence

Community by the President and formally makes the NRO a part

of the Intelligence Community.

ACTIONS NEEDED

- 1. An NSCID for the NRO.
 - The Executive Order requires that existing NSCIDs be amended.
 - Mr. Latimer suggests that we draft an NECLD to be given to Mr. Ellsworth.
 - An NSCID can be the vehicle for assuring continued streamlined management.
 - It should establish the DNRO in a joint agency management role.
 - It can deal with the "fact of."
- 2. A CFID may be needed to cover the NRO.
 - It could cover conduct of "ExComs" including membership.
 - It could serve to outline relationships with OMB.
 - The NRO action to recommend appropriate inputs to CFIDs.
- DOD Directive 5100.23 needs revision.
 - Could be issued an extra or TALENT-KEYHOLE or TOP SECRET.
 - NRO action, for Mr. Ellsworth.
- 4. Waiver to section V on surveillance.
- The NRO Staff is preparing requests for necessary waivers to permit Continental U.S. testing of our collection systems.
- 5. Reorganization of USIB.
 - We need to continue to work in a USIB-type framework.
