

MEMORANDUM FOR MR. PLUMMER DR. COOK CWC

SUBJECT: NRO Briefing to Intelligence Oversight Board Staff

In response to Mr. Ellsworth's desire to be notified of briefings on intelligence activities requested by outside agencies, we have prepared the memo at the right for your signature.

Major SAFLL, has been addressing the Executive Order implementation and has been in contact with the Intelligence Oversight Board (IOB) staff members; he will be present for the NRO briefing. We are anticipating that the actual requirements levied on the NRO will be minimal.

Our proposed revision to the NRO Charter calls for oversight by the DOD Inspector General. It now appears that this function may not be implemented, which will leave open the question of who provides inspection oversight for the NRO. We will discuss the implications of this with the IOB staff.
